# Merit Badge Day April 27, 2024 Faith Lutheran Church, Naples, Florida

Welcome to Merit Badge Day. This is an opportunity for all ages of Scouts to earn merit badges of their choosing. Class sizes are limited, please register early as placement is based on a first completed registration basis.

The purpose of Merit Badge day is to give Scouts an opportunity to begin, continue or even complete a merit badge of their choosing. Some merit badges presented during this merit badge day will be able to completed in their entirety at this event, others had pre or post requisites that must be completed outside of the course.

# Check In

Upon arrival to Faith Lutheran Church, please sign in at the check-in desk in the lobby. From here, you will be directed to the meeting space for the morning course you are registered for. During the lunch break, again, sign in to the afternoon sessions at the check-in desk in the lobby and you will be directed to your next meeting space.

# <u>Lunch</u>

Brown bag lunch is required as there are no dining facilities nor food located on premises. Please bring what you need to satisfy you through the entire course. A lunch period is designated. A water bottle is required. and clean water is available.

# Check Out

All Scouts are required to sign out before being dismissed from Merit Badge Day. Scouts are permitted to leave at the end of the first session, but must sign out before doing so. Parents should be prepared to pick up their youth immediately following the end of the course at 4:00 PM. Please be aware that all Merit Badge Day cadre will depart the facility by 4:30 PM.

# **Environment**

These courses will be held in a conference or classroom, with temperatures varying and non-adjustable. The Traffic Safety, Weather, Photography, First Aid and Fingerprinting courses may include outdoor components. Please dress accordingly for all environments. Separate indoor facilities for both men and women will be available at all times during the day.


# **Requirements**

Smart phones are required for in-course research and visits to online museums. Not all meeting facilities have WIFI, yet it will be posted whenever available. It is highly advisable to bring a pen/pencil and writing paper to write on and take notes during the courses. #### **Course Selection**

Merit badge courses are presented in both a morning 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM session and an afternoon 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM session. Scouts may select both a morning and an afternoon merit badge course. By referencing the course schedule chart, you will notice that First Aid and Traffic Safety are longer courses and only Fingerprinting or American Cultures may be taken as the second afternoon course.

Although there are no age limits on individual courses, as every Scout learns at their own pace; all Scouts might not complete all of the requirements designated for the day. This is not an issue, as any in-completed requirements can be completed at the troop level.



#### **Course schedule chart**

NOTE: The American Cultures and Fingerprinting merit badge courses may only be taken if you are taking a First Aid or Traffic Safety Course. You may still choose which of the two courses you would like to take.

Example 1: You may take First Aid and Fingerprinting OR American Cultures.

Example 2: You may not take Citizenship in the Community and Fingerprinting, because that leaves you with two hours of sitting around waiting, and we don't have the space or personnel to accommodate this.

Example 3: You may take Citizenship in the Community and Weather OR American Business OR American Heritage or Citizenship of the Nation.
