Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) Training is a hands-on course providing adult leaders with the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts BSA in the out-of-doors. Leaders should feel comfortable teaching Scouts the basic skills required to obtain the First-Class rank. This course (along with Scoutmaster Specifics) is required of all direct contact leaders in a Scouts BSA troop to be considered "trained".

Cancellation Policy: The Cancellation policy is in effect once registration fees have been paid and an individual becomes ill or otherwise unable to attend an event. As the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, insurance, food, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferable. You may request a refund by submitting it in writing to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 72 hours before the date of the event. In most cases, only a partial refund can be made. **Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.** No refunds will be given on the Event Processing Fee.
