WHAT IS NYLT?

NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING IS AN EXCITING, ACTION-PACKED PROGRAM DESIGNED TO PROVIDE NEXT LEVEL LEADERSHIP SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE TO YOUTH WHO HAVE ALREADY DEMONSTRATED LEADERSHIP IN THEIR UNIT. THIS COURSE IS THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF TRAINING OFFERED TO YOUTH BY A COUNCIL.

THE NYLT COURSE CENTERS AROUND THE CONCEPTS OF WHAT A LEADER MUST BE, WHAT HE/SHE MUST KNOW, AND WHAT HE/SHE MUST DO. THE KEY ELEMENTS ARE THEN TAUGHT WITH A CLEAR FOCUS ON HOW TO.

INSTRUCTION IS CONDUCTED IN A PATROL OUTDOOR SETTINGH WIT AN EMPHASIS ON IMMEDIATE APPLICATION OF LEARNING IN A FUN ENVIRONMENT. INTERCONNECTING CONCEPTS AND WORK PROCESSES ARE INTRODUCED EARLY, BUILT UPON, AND AIDED BY THE USE OF MEMORY AIDS.

 A DESIRE TO LEARN NEXT LEVEL LEADERSHIP SKILLS
- BE APPROVED BY THE YOUTH'S UNIT LEADER BASED UPON THE CANDIDATE'S MATURITY AND ATTITUDE.


