ADVISER'S MINUTE

WHAT'S NEW AT CAMP FLYING EAGLE?

For those who attended Fall Fellowship, you had an opportunity to see the early stages of our new Order of the Arrow Ceremonial Fire Ring at Camp Flying Eagle. Originally, the Lodge's intention was to refurbish and upgrade the existing OA Ceremonial Fire Ring. After quite a bit of conversation with Gary Hoyt, a local architect and Osceola Arrowman, and Todd Greene, the Ranger at CFE, the Lodge Executive Committee recommended that we build a new Ceremonial Fire Ring at Camp Flying Eagle.

When we compared the benefits of each, the new location could not be washed away by a flood from a heavy rain, it was easy to access and the possibility of slipping and getting hurt was removed, this easier access also allowed for easier maintenance of the site, and it was large enough to accommodate over 250 Arrowmen during a Ceremony. During an Ordeal Ceremony in 2022 at Camp Miles, we had 196 Arrowmen in attendance at an Ordeal Ceremony and we overfilled the OA Ceremonial Fire Ring.

If you had the opportunity to visit our new OA site at CFE, you would have seen a 120' diameter circle cleared of all trees and brush. The Lodge thanks Gary Hoyt for his efforts in arranging to have this area cleared at no cost to the Lodge. Our next step will be to grade the area and then layout the fire ring, the ceremonial area and the seating area. There is still a lot to do and we hope that you are willing to help.

The impressive decision that your Lodge Executive Committee made was to develop the area for everyone to use. A Cub Scout Pack could use it for a monthly outing. It could be used for a Cross-over Ceremony when AOL Scouts cross over into a Scout Troop. Scout Troops could use it for a Court of Honor, or even for an Eagle Scout Court of Honor. And, yes, Venturing Crews and Sea Scout Ships will be able to use it. Above all, it will be used for Ordeal, Brotherhood and Vigil Honor Ceremonies by the Arrowmen and Ceremonialists of Osceola Lodge. It can be used by all and enjoyed by all.
